**LIBERATOR TACTICAL LIGHT**

## TRUE AT FIRST LIGHT

Although conventional cylindrical tactical flashlights have been on the market for decades, military and law enforcement special operators have always had to overcome the constant problem of having one's hands occupied with holding the device. Mounted weapons-lights are good for illuminating a target, but once the threat has been neutralized, an operator is still forced to use his entire weapon system as a light source.

The **Liberator Tactical Light** from First Light is the only non-mounted tactical illuminator on the market that allows for a two-handed combat grip in conjunction with a firearm. The Liberator is an ergonomically-designed, all-purpose light with a durable retention strap that conforms to all hand and glove sizes for easy fitting and effortless operation; strap the Liberator onto your hand, turn on the light, and move on to other tasks. The problems of having to drop your flashlight or holster your weapon to perform a two-handed task are gone; both hands are constantly free to use a weapon, cuff a suspect, or operate another piece of equipment.

The 3-Watt Lumileds Luxeon Star emitter provides eighty lumens of light at full power, and, with three different brightness levels on an intuitive selector switch, finding the correct amount of light for any situation is easy (the Liberator will run for sixty hours on the lowest setting and ninety minutes on the highest). The rigors of tactical ops aren't likely to damage the Liberator; the LED housing on the light is constructed of aerospace-grade aluminum and the linking member is made from a nearly-indestructible carbon-filled polymer.

The Liberator Control Board, which is housed in a permanently-sealed environment to prevent water or grit damage, features: a lockout mode to prevent accidental activation of the light; a Constant-On control for continuous illumination; the three-way brightness control; and, a momentary control to provide instant light when not in Constant-On mode, and also to instantly transition to full intensity from any brightness level.

The Liberator has been shown to give police officers a twenty-three percent marksmanship improvement over conventional tactical flashlights.
